We cordially invite you to the meeting of the International Pemphigus and Pemphigoid Foundation (IPPF) that will take place in Lübeck on Thursday, June 22nd and Friday, June 23rd, 2017.

By this meeting, we will follow the tradition of previous IPPF meetings in 2001, 2005, and 2010 bringing together clinical and scientific experts in the field of autoimmune bullous disorders with patients suffering from these diseases. This will be the first IPPF meeting outside the US and we are happy and honored to host this event in Lübeck. The meeting will be preceded by a welcome reception at St. Petri Church on Wednesday evening (June 21st).

We expect around 150 participants at this symposium, which will take place in the medieval city of Lübeck surrounded by the moats of the ancient fortification. Lübeck is an UNESCO World Heritage Site and was the political center of the Hanse, a flourishing medieval trade union.

Several hotels will be available within walking distance to the congress venue.

The websites of both the IPPF and the Lübeck Institute of Experimental Dermatology (LIED) will provide information on registration, hotels and submission of abstracts later this fall.
